

Radish and carrot gift-wrapping workshop



What do we need?

1. Mat for wet felting. I use ribbed kitchen cupboard mat from IKEA shop. It sold in rolls in kitchen section of IKEA. You can find something similar.
2. Scissors with sharp ends.
3. Piece of mesh fabric or a piece of tulle.
4. Soap.
5. Water container.
6. Needle felting tools: mat (dishwashing sponge is fine) and felting needle size 38, gauge star. You can manage without.
7. Roll of toilet paper.
8. Roll of thin garbage plastic bags.
9. Material to make a template. I use 2mm thick piece of laminate underlay, but just a thick plastic bag or bubble wrap will do. Any plastic material that is soft, pliable and does not stick to the wool will work.
10. Wool: I use Australian extra fine merino wool in tops (18-21 mic), but it is possible to use any wool. For one ready vegetable (25 cm tall including leaves) I have used 25 g of wool. For the radish: red, white, green, for the carrot: orange and green.
11. Decoration. I have my veggies purely woolly but it is possible to decorate them with

fibers: silk, viscose, linen etc. And even use some pieces of fabrics or yarns.

12. Wool threads to embroider and sewing needle – it is up to you.

13. Thin kitchen towel or a piece of old cotton or linen fabric.

14. Razor, if you will use coarse wool.

15. Filling for the wrap – nice candies and chocolate eggs.
