Radish and carrot gift-wrapping workshop



What do we need?

1. Mat for wet felting. I use ribbed kitchen cupboard mat from IKEA shop. It sold in rolls in kitchen section of IKEA. You can find something similar.

2. Scissors with sharp ends.

- 3. Piece of mesh fabric or a piece of tulle.
- 4. Soap.
- 5. Water container.

6. Needle felting tools: mat (dishwashing sponge is fine) and felting needle size 38, gauge star. You can manage without.

- 7. Roll of toilet paper.
- 8. Roll of thin garbage plastic bags.

9. Material to make a template. I use 2mm thick piece of laminate underlay, but just a thick plastic bag or bubble wrap will do. Any plastic material that is soft, pliable and does not stick to the wool will work.

10. Wool: I use Australian extra fine merino wool in tops (18-21 mic), but it is possible to use any wool. For one ready vegetable (25 cm tall including leaves) I have used 25 g of wool. For the radish: red, white, green, for the carrot: orange and green.

11. Decoration. I have my veggies purely woolly but it is possible to decorate them with

fibers: silk, viscose, linen etc. And even use some pieces of fabrics or yarns.

- 12. Wool threads to embroider and sewing needle it is up to you.
- 13. Thin kitchen towel or a piece of old cotton or linen fabric.
- 14. Razor, if you will use coarse wool.
- 15. Filling for the wrap nice candies and chocolate eggs.
